1. The Competition is sanctioned by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
2. All entrants **MUST** be current eligible members in good standing as defined by the Ice Skating Association of Ireland.
3. The Competition will be held at the Lee Valley Ice Centre, London on the **1st to 4th April 2019**.
4. The ice surface is 60m x 30m, with slightly rounded corners.
5. Irish Figure Skating Championships will include the following categories in LADIES and MEN
 - 5.1. Basic Novice
 - 5.2. Intermediate Novice
 - 5.3. Advanced Novice
 - 5.4. Junior
 - 5.5. Senior
6. All categories requirements for are in accordance with current ISAI and ISU Rules. Please see attached programme technical criteria summary for entry regulations. The qualifying date for Minimum Test requirements is the **1st March 2019**.
7. All events will be conducted under the Competition Rules of the ISAI and ISU. A skater may only compete in **one** category as per Section 700.
8. By participating in this ISAI Championship there is an acceptance that participants consent and agree to be bound by these rules.
9. All events will be judged under ISU regulations using the IJS system.
10. In all events, **Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior**, the competitors will skate both a **Short and Free** programme.
11. The entry **deadline** is **5PM on the 1st March 2019**. For information email info@isai.ie
Late entries will **NOT** be accepted under any circumstances.
12. All entries **MUST** be submitted through ISAI online Events system on the ISAI website. You can only access this from your ISAI account. Entries **MUST** include a working email address for information to be sent to the competitor. All entries **MUST** be submitted with a **COMPLETED PLANNED PROGRAMME FORM**.
13. Payment should be made online at the time of entry application.
14. The entry fee is **non-refundable**.
15. Refunds will only be given if a category is not held.
16. The ISAI reserve the right to refuse entry without reason or to cancel a category. The ISAI's Board's **decision is final**.
17. The ISAI reserve the right to change both competition venue and date should circumstances beyond the ISAI control merit it. The ISAI assumes no responsibility for competitor's costs under any circumstances.
18. All competitors are required to register as soon as they arrive at the rink. Music must be turned in at the time of official registration and will not be returned until the conclusion of the event.
19. Music must be on CDs and **CLEARLY** marked with the competitor's name and the competition entered. Programme music **MUST** be the only piece of music on the CD.

20. Once turned in, the ISAI will accept no responsibility for breakage, damage or loss of CDs but will take every precaution to ensure their safety. All competitors must have an extra copy of their CD available during the actual competition.
21. The draw for each event will take place prior to the competition and order of skaters will be posted on the official notice board in the ice rink before the competition. The skate order for Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior **Free Programmes** will be in reverse order.
22. The official schedule showing starting times for each event and the draw will be posted on the bulletin board. The official schedule supersedes all other schedules. Notices posted on this bulletin board are considered as sufficient notice to all competitors.
23. Skaters are to be in the rink and ready to skate 30 minutes before their event is scheduled to begin. Events will not be delayed for skaters who arrive late.
24. Winners of the Championship Event will be entitled to use the title of Irish Novice / Junior / Senior Champion. Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
25. Presentations will take place as soon as possible after the last competition.
26. By participating in this ISAI event there is an acceptance that participants consent to being photographed / videoed by an official ISAI photographer for the duration of the event and that these images may be published by the ISAI in appropriate media."
27. This competition is subject to **DOPING CONTROL** as recommended by the International Olympic Committee and the ISU.
28. It is recommended that all competitors have appropriate insurance cover.
29. ISAI will not be liable for any accidents or damage, howsoever caused, to any competitor or to any official appointed by ISAI arising out of or in connection with the activities of ISAI.
