Testing Bronze Free Skate Through Competition (BRONZE ONLY)

It has been decided that when testing <u>BRONZE FREE SKATE TEST ONLY</u> through competition – As there are few, if any, competitions on the circuit with a programme duration of 1.30 (as per our Bronze Test requirements) that the ISAI will accept a 2 minute programme, which is the most common programme duration at this beginner level. <u>PLEASE NOTE HOWEVER THAT ALL OF THE TECHNICAL CRITERIA WILL REMAIN THE SAME</u>.

- 3 JUMPS, [jumps performed are as per the Bronze test];
- 2 different SPINS; and
- · A step sequence

NOTE: The <u>only</u> change to the current rule is that the programme can be AT LEAST 1.30 but can now be UP TO **2 minutes** and must still contain all of the technical criteria.

ALSO NOTE: Existing Rule 502.1 pertaining to this BRONZE FREE SKATE TEST from Section 500 is shown on Page 2 of this Communication highlighting the change.

SINGLES "NATIONAL" TEST STANDARDS TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

502.1 "NATIONAL" BRONZE FREE SKATE TEST

502.1.1

A free programme of 1 minute 30 seconds (+/- 10 sec) duration with music comprising linking steps and movements which must be in time and in character with the rhythm of the music chosen. ONLY CHANGE IS THAT DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME CAN NOW BE 2 MINUTES (+/- 10 sec)

502.1.2

Technical requirement

- Maximum of 3 jump elements
 - i. Must include a Toeloop & Salchow.
 - ii. Maximum of one (1) jump combination. Where a sequence is performed, only the 2 most difficult jumps will be counted. These jumps can be a repeat of (a).
 - iii. Waltz Jumps will be counted as an unlisted jumps part of Transitions, worth 0 points. They will not block a jump box.
- 2. There must be a maximum of two (2) basic position spins of a different nature (abbreviation)
 - i. No change of foot or position is allowed
 - ii. Minimum of 3 revolutions total per spin (at least 2 revolutions must be in position for the position to be called)
- 3. There must be a maximum of one (1) step sequence covering at least three quarters (75%) of the ice surface.

502.1.3

In all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the technical panel.

502.1.4

The test will be marked in Program Components: Skating Skills and Performance/Execution but this will not contribute to the passing score.
