



2026/2027 ISAI TEST PASSING SCORES

Please read in conjunction with ISAI Rules Section 500

In line with the changes to qualification scores by the ISU in 2025, whereby Combined Total Elements Scores (CTES) from both programme segments is considered for qualification purposes, the Ice Skating Association of Ireland is changing the rule for calculation of TES for test passing scores in Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior categories in Singles, Pairs and Ice Dance.

Effective from 1 July 2026, the ISAI will require a minimum Combined Total Elements Scores (CTES) for passing a test level.

Skaters/Pairs/Couples wishing to pass a test must submit competition protocols for both Short Programme/Rhythm Dance and Free Skate/Free Dance (SP/RD + FS/FD) to the ISAI along with payment of the relevant fee. Protocols from the current season and/or the preceding season only will be considered for test purposes.

As the scale of value for Singles and Pairs has increased the base value of several elements in both the short and free programs in the 2026/2027 season, the Combined Total Elements Score (CTES) has been updated to reflect this change.

The CTES for Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior categories in Singles, Pairs and Ice Dance are outlined below.
